VOTING PLACES

Voting places will be open for voting on **Wednesday the 24th day of October, 2018** between 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. at:

WARD 1 – Inwood Memorial Community Center, 1079 PTH 17 W, Inwood, MB

WARD 2 – Chatfield Community Club, 4158 Oak Island Lake Road, Chatfield, MB

WARD 3 – Silver Community Centre, 10025 Road 125 NE, Silver, MB

WARD 4 – Fraserwood Hall, 10140 PR 231, Fraserwood, MB

WARD 5 – Polson Community Club, 102152 Road 4E, Polson, MB

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example – driver's licence or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at **Inwood Memorial Community Center, 1079 PTH 17 W, Inwood, MB for Wards 1 & 2** and at **Fraserwood Hall, 10140 PR 231, Fraserwood, MB for Wards 3, 4 & 5** and will be open on **Thursday, October 11th, 2018** between 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing or by fax to the senior election official at the Rural Municipality of Armstrong Municipal Office, Box 69, Inwood, MB R0C 1P0 or 1-204-278-3437 (fax number).

If applying in person*, a voter may apply between September 26 and October 21, 2018.

*A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application.

If applying by mail or fax**, a voter may apply between July 26 and October 21, 2018.

** A voter applying by mail or fax will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the senior election official.
