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#### THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ARMSTRONG BY-LAW NO. 6/04

## BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ARMSTRONG TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND DEVELOPMENT OF LAND AND BUILDINGS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ARMSTRONG

WHEREAS Section 39(1) of The Planning Act (the Act) provides that the Council of a municipality may enact a Zoning By-Law which generally conforms to a Development Plan adopted for the area;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 27(1) of the Act, the R.M. of Armstrong has, by by-law, adopted the Fisher Armstrong Planning District Development Plan;

AND WHEREAS Section 32(2) of the Act provides that the Council of a municipality shall enact a Zoning By-Law upon the adoption of a Development Plan for the area;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Armstrong enacts as follows:

1. The Zoning By-Law, attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law, is hereby adopted.

2. This By-Law shall be known as the R.M. of Armstrong Zoning By-Law.

3. The R.M. of Armstrong Zoning By-Law shall take force and effect on the date of Third Reading of this By-Law.
